Dear Friends,

Here we are in June 2023 and we are delighted to inform you that four of our young students have now graduated. All of them achieved Upper Second Class Honours degrees in their particular specialties, and we could not be more pleased with their successes.

The four young men are still studying. Two of them graduate in December this year and two of them the following year. These two are doing well, though one, Nicholas Bvumbura, is still struggling to secure an attachment to a working mine as part of his Diploma course requirements. The dire economic situation is making his search extremely difficult.

The youngest member of this group is Chantelle Ncube who is 14 years old and studying at Queen Elizabeth School in Harare and is flourishing. Find out more about each of the students in the newsletter, and great photos of the young ladies in the graduation outfits.

Zimbabwe however remains a basket case. Mnangagwa still rules the country with an iron fist and little aid is forthcoming as the Government refuse to reform. What little aid is coming in is emergency aid. There are a number of young farmers who have returned to farm, renting land from the new powerful owners and farming with moveable assets. Sadly, as the Government has no money, no headway has been made in compensating farmers for their stolen immovable assets and so negotiations continue with Government around this issue.

Any support you feel you could give would be hugely welcome.
